Thomas Dörflinger was born in Laupheim in 1969. After graduating from the Gymnasium Biberach and subsequent military service in Mengen and Ummendorf, he trained as a banker at Landesgirokasse Stuttgart. He went on to study business administration at the University of Applied Sciences in Nürtingen, graduating with a degree in business administration. Subsequently, Thomas Dörflinger worked as a fund-of-funds manager and fund researcher at Baden-Württembergische Bank and later as an asset manager at Kreissparkasse Biberach.

Thomas Dörflinger has been a member of the State Parliament of Baden-Württemberg since 2016. During this time, he has served as the spokesperson for skilled crafts and trades policy for the CDU parliamentary group. From 2017 to 2026, he was also the chair of the working group on transport and the spokesperson for transport policy. From 2021 to 2026, he served as deputy chair of the CDU parliamentary group. In March 2026, he was re-elected to the State Parliament of Baden-Württemberg.

On May 13, 2026, Thomas Dörflinger was appointed State Secretary in the Ministry of Economic Affairs, Skilled Crafts and Tourism of the State of Baden-Württemberg.

Thomas Dörflinger lives with his family in the municipality of Ummendorf in the district of Biberach. He is a member of various associations and is active, among other roles, as chair of the foundation board of the Ummendorf Community Foundation (*Bürgerstiftung Ummendorf*).
